Steele of the same place of the second part Witnesseth that the said parties of the first ^{party} for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and forty seven \$247.00 Dollars, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged doth give, grant, bargain sell release, convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns forever, all the following described land, situated in said County of Douglas in Kansas Territory, to wit: Lot seventy five (75) Kentucky Street in the City of Lawrence together with the dwellinghouse situate on said lot together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging or in anywise appertaining both in law and Equity - This Grant is Intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Two hundred and forty seven \$247.00 Dollars according to the terms of a certain Promissory Note bearing Evendate hereof as follows to wit: On or before the 1st day of August A.D. 1859. for value received I promise to pay to the order of J. C. Steele the sum of Two hundred and forty seven \$247.00 Dollars with interest at the rate of twenty five per cent per annum until paid. which Note has been this day Executed and delivered by the said
