sold and quit claimed, and by these presents do bargain sell  
and, and quit claim unto the said J A Finley his  
Executors, administrators, and assigns from all my  
right, title, interest, claim, and demand in and to  
the following described land situated and lying  
in the Town of Lawrence in the Territory of Kansas  
according to the survey made by A D Seal A.D. 1857.  
to wit Lot Number sixteen (16) in Kirkney Street. And  
I John Bowles of usaid my heirs Executors, administrators  
and assigns do hold and quit claim by these presents in  
the sum of Two Hundred Dollars to said J A Finley  
of usaid his heirs, Executors, administrators and assigns  
to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them  
all the title which I shall receive from the Justices of the  
said Town of Lawrence, or from any power or person  
or persons whomsoever, to any and all of the above described  
property To Have and Hold the same, with all the buildings  
and appurtenances therewith belonging severally. In Witness
