in the State of Kansas, according to the survey
made by C. P. Starbuck, 1854, to wit: Lots number
Forty six & forty eight (46 & 48.) Louisiana Street,
and all the appurtenances and improvements
thereunto belonging. And I Freeman N Blake aforesaid
my heirs, Executrix, administrators, and assigns
are held and firmly bound by these presents in the
sum of One thousand Dollars, to said Mr.
Fias aforesaid his heirs, Executrix, administrators
and assigns to well and truly make over and
convey unto him or them all the title which
I shall receive from the trustees of the said
Town of Lawrence or from any power, or person
or persons whomsoever, to any and all of the
above described property to have and to hold
the same with all the franchises and appurtenan-
ces thereunto belonging forever In Witness
