are held and firmly bound by these presents  
in the sum of Two thousand Hundred  
Dollars, to the said Franklin Kimball  
his heirs and assigns, to make and  
convey unto him or them all further right  
or title which shall or may be awarded or  
conveyed to me by any person or persons  
by virtue of a title to the town site of Lawrence  
aforesaid issuing from the General Land Office  
In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set  
our hands and seals this Eleventh day  
of September A.D. 1858.
