This Indenture, made this Eleventh day of September in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Eight hundred and fifty Eight between Samuel Kimball Frederick Kimball Franklin Kimball and Edward Kimball, partners under the name and firm of Kimball Brothers of the City of Lawrence Territory of Kansas of the first part and Hiram Towne of the City of Lawrence aforesaid of the second part. Witnesseth that the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of "Four Hundred and fifty" Dollars the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged doth give, grant, bargain, sell, release convey and confirm unto the said parties of the second part and to their heirs and assigns, forever all the following described land situated in the aforesaid City of Lawrence Kansas Territory to wit: Reserve Number six (6), saving and excepting therefrom a rectangular lot in the south West corner thereof, extending from the corner of Pinkney and Tennessee Streets Sixty (60) feet along said Pinkney Street and one hundred (100) feet along said Tennessee Street, together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging or in anywise appertaining both in law and Equity - This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the
