 That I William H Bloss of the Town  
 of Lawrence Territory of Kansas, for  
 and in consideration of the sum of  
 One Hundred Dollars to me in hand  
 paid by John H. Parks of the same  
 place the receipt whereof is hereby  
 acknowledged have bargained, sold  
 and quit claimed, and by these pres-  
 ents do bargain, sell, and quit claim unto  
 the said John H. Parks his heirs,  
 Executors, administrators, and assigns  
 forever, all my right, title, interest, claim  
 and demand in and to the following  
 described land, situate and lying in  
 the Town of Lawrence, in the Territory  
 of Kansas, according to the survey made  
 by A. H. Seal et al. 1854. To wit: Lot  
 Number One Hundred and Ten  
 (110) Delaware Street. And I William  
 H. Bloss aforesaid my heirs, Executors  
 administrators, and assigns are held  
 and firmly bound by these presents  
 in the sum Five Hundred Dollars  
 to the said John H. Parks aforesaid  
 his heirs, Executors, administrators  
 to well and truly make over and  
 convey unto him or them all the  
 title which I shall receive from the  
 Trustees of said Town of Lawrence, or from  
 any power or person or persons whomsoever  
 to any and all of the above described property  
 to have and to hold the same with all  
 the privileges and appurtenances thereto
