To Have and To Hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances therunto belonging forever - And William Hanson do hereby covenant with the said Hiram Burnett his heirs Executors, administrators, and assigns; that I and my heirs, Executors and administrators shall and will warrant and defend the said premises to him and them against the lawful claims and demands of all persons claiming by, from, or under us, And I hereby bind myself, and my heirs
