

Know all men by these Presents That we Henry Brown and Rhoda A his wife of the City of Lawrence Territory of Kansas, for and in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred Dollars to us in hand paid by the Philipp Albach of Lawrence aforesaid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained sold and quit claimed and by these presents do bargain sell and quit claim unto the said Philipp Albach and to his heirs and assigns forever, all our right title, Estate interest, claim and demand, in possession now in expectancy of in and to the following described lands, situated in the City of Lawrence aforesaid, to wit: Lot number sixty five <sup>(65)</sup> in Massachusetts. To Have and To Hold the above described premises, with the privileges and appurtenances there belonging, unto the said Philipp Albach his heirs and assigns forever, and we the said Henry and Rhoda A for ourselves and our heirs, Executors and administrators do covenant with the Philipp Albach his heirs and assigns that the said premises are free from all Encumbrances, made or suffered by us; that we leave full right and power to sell convey and quit claim the same and that I shall and will warrant and defend the same unto the said Albach his heirs and assigns from against the lawful claims and demands of all persons claiming by through or under me but against none other. And we the said Henry & Rhoda A. our heirs, Executors and administrators, are held and firmly bound by these with the sum of Six Hundred Dollars to the said Philipp Albach his heirs and assigns, to make and convey unto him in them all further right of title which shall or may be awarded or conveyed to us by any authority or by any person or persons by virtue of a title to the same set of Lawrence aforesaid issuing from the General Land office.
