is hereby acknowledged has bargained sold and quit  
claimed, and by these presents does bargain, sell, and quit  
claim unto the said Moses Scott his heirs, Executors, adm-  
inistrators, and assigns, forever, all my right, title, interest  
claim, and demand in and to the following described land  
situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the Territory  
of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D. Seal <sup>1854</sup>  
to wit, The North half of Lot Number Forty (40)  
in Massachusetts Street. And I John P. Wood  
aforesaid my heirs, Executors, administrators and  
assigns, am held and firmly bound by these presents  
in the sum of One thousand Dollars to Moses Scott,  
aforesaid his heirs, Executors, administrators, and assigns  
to well and truly make over and convey unto him or  
them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees  
of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power or persons  
or persons whatsoever, to any and all of the above described  
property, To Have and to Hold the same with all the  
privileges and appurtenances therunto belonging forever.
