

Discharged See Book "A" of Mortgages  
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This Indenture made this first day of October in  
the Year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and  
fifty eight Between Albert Newman his wife Lucia  
M of Douglas County Territory of Kansas of the first  
part, and Rollin Richmond of Saint Louis State  
of Missouri of the second part, Witnesseth that the  
said parties of the first part, for and in consideration  
of the sum of Two Hundred and forty Dollars, the  
receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged doth give  
grant bargain sell release, convey and confirm unto  
the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns  
forever, all the following described land, situated in the  
City of Lawrence Kansas Territory to wit Lot No Eighty  
seven (87) Vermont Street according to the survey made  
of A. D. Seal in the Year of our Lord (1854) Eighteen  
fifty four, together with all and singular the  
hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging  
in any way appertaining both in law and Equity—  
This Grant is intended as a mortgage, to secure the  
payment of the sum of Two Hundred and forty Dollars  
due and payable in one Year from the fifteenth day  
of July A. D. 1858, with interest after maturity, at  
the rate of five per cent per month until paid,  
according to the conditions of a certain promissory  
Note Executed and delivered by the said Albert  
Newman, on the sixteenth day of July A. D. 1858,  
to the said party of the second part, and this Conveyance  
shall be void if such payment be made as herein specified  
But if default be made in the payment of the money  
above mentioned, or of the interest that may accrue  
thereon, or of any part thereof, then it shall be  
lawful for the party of the second part his Executors  
administrators or assigns to sell the premises,  
hereby granted or any part thereof at public  
auction; such sale to be upon the said
