

premises, first giving notice of date and place
 of sale, by publishing the same three times in succession
 in some newspaper printed in the aforesaid (or if there be
 no newspaper printed in the County, aforesaid, such
 notice may be published in some newspaper printed
 in the City of Lawrence Kansas,) the last publication
 of said Notice to be made at least six days before the
 time of sale, and it shall be lawful for the said
 party of the second part or his agent for such purpose
 duly authorized in his own name, to make and
 deliver to the purchaser or purchasers of said premises
 a good and sufficient deed of Conveyance of the
 same, in fee simple, and out of the money
 arising from such sale to retain the principal
 sum, whether due or thereafter payable, and
 also the interest which shall then remain due thereon
 and also all costs, charges and expenses attending
 said together with — dollars, to be reserved
 by the said party of the second part, or his agent, as
 remuneration for trouble arising from such sale
 paying the surplus, if any there be, to the said party
 of the first part Executors, administrators and
 assigns. And the said party of the second part
 is hereby empowered to prescribe the terms and
 conditions of said sale; and such sale so to be
 made shall bear a perpetual bar in law and equity
 against the said parties of the first part their heirs
 and assigns, and all other persons claiming or
 to claim the premises, in any part thereof, by
 him or under him, them, or any of them —
