This Indenture Made this Eighteenth day of October in the Year of our Lord One thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty, between Camille W. Babcock and William H. R. Lykins of the City of Lawrence Kansas of the first part, and Edward D. Thompson of the same place of the second part Witnesseth that the said party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of Fifteen Hundred Dollars, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, doth give grant bargain sell, release convey, and confirm unto the said party of the second part, and his heirs and assigns, forever, all the following described land situated in the City of Lawrence Kansas Territory to-wit: The North half of Lot No 25 (Twenty five) on Massachusetts St. as described on the map and survey of said City made by A. D. Seal Oct. 1854. together with all and singular the tenements hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging in anywise appertaining both in law and Equity. This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Fifteen Hundred Dollars in one Year from the date hereof. according to the conditions of a certain promissory note this day Executed and delivered by the said Babcock & Lykins to the said Thompson, payable in one Year from date with interest payable quarterly to the said party of the second part or his order, and this mortgage shall be void if such payment be made as herein specified. But if default be made in the payment or any part thereof or the interest thereof as above provided then it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part, his heirs administrators and assigns, at any time
