

Know all men by these presents, that I John D Wood of Lawrence Territory of Kansas for and in consideration of the sum of sixty five Dollars to me in hand paid by David W Mitchell of Douglas County Kt. the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained sold and quit claimed and by these presents do bargain sell and quit claim unto the said Mitchell his heirs and assigns, Executors, administrators, and assigns forever, all my right, title, interest, claim, and demand in and to the following described land, situated and lying in Lawrence in the Territory of Kansas, to wit: Lot Numbered Eighty five (85) in New York street according to survey and plan made by A D Seal Oct AD 1854. To Have and to Hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging forever. And I the said John D Wood do, hereby covenant with the said Mitchell his heirs Executors, administrators, and assigns: that I and my heirs, Executors, and administrators shall and will warrant, and defend the said premises to him and them against the lawful claims and demands of all persons claiming by, from or under us and I hereby bind myself and my heirs in the sum of One Hundred Dollars to the said Mitchell his heirs and assigns to make good to them any further title I may obtain to said lot.
