 party of the first part in consideration of Ninety Dollars to
 him in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the
 receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents, release
 and forever quit claim unto the said party of the second part
 all that certain piece or parcel of land situated in the City of
 Lawrence in the County of Douglas, and Territory of Kansas
 to wit: Lot Number (117) One Hundred and seventeen, and
 lot Number (119) One Hundred and Nineteen, on Delaware
 Street according to the survey made by A D Seal in October
 A.D. 1854. Eighteen Hundred and fifty four. To Have and to
 Hold the same, together with all the rights immunities privileges
 and appurtenances to the same belonging, unto the said party of
 the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever. In
