

This Indenture made and Entered into this twenty ninth
 day of May A.D. 1858. by and between Prastus Q Ladd,
 Abram Wilder, John S Brown Ephraim Hute Junior, and
 James Bliss Trustees of the first Unitarian society of Lawrence Kansas
 Territory parties of the first part, and the American Unitarian Association
 a Corporation Established by law of the Commonwealth of Massach-
 usetts party of the second part Witnesseth whereas the said party
 of the second part, by Deed of Condate herewith have sold and
 conveyed unto the parties of the first part, in Trust, for the use
 and benefit of the First Unitarian Society of Lawrence Kansas
 the following described Real Estate and property to wit: Lot Number
 (127) One Hundred and Twenty seven and (129) One Hundred and
 twenty nine on Ohio Street in said Town in City of Lawrence in
 Douglas County said Territory, together with all the appurtenances
 therunto appertaining and the Church Building situate thereon &c.
 for the sum of \$5000. Five Thousand Dollars to be paid here-
 in after by annual instalments and wherein it has been agreed
 between the party of the second part, hereto, and said Trustees acting
 in behalf of said First Unitarian Society of Lawrence that said
 Trustees as security for the payment of the said sum of Five Thousand
 Dollars purchase Money shall Execute to the party of the second
 part, hereto a Mortgage DEED of the same lots and property;
 and whereas the said Trustees have been Elected according to laws,
 by said society as such, to receive the title to said Lots and
 property and appurtenances in trust for the use and benefit of the
 said society and to do such other things and acts for the benefit of
 said society as by law they may; and whereas by a regular
 vote of said society as a Meeting thereof the said Trustees were
 Empowered to make purchase of said Lots Nos 127 and 129,
 on Ohio Street the appurtenances, Church Building thereon &c.
 and to Execute a Mortgage DEED thereon for the security of
 the purchase money thereof: Now therefore this Indenture
 Witnesseth that the said parties of the first part, in consideration
 of the premises have Granted bargain'd, sold and conveyed
 and by these presents do Grant bargain sell and convey.
