To Have and to Hold the above described property, with the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said John Sayers his heirs and assigns forever. And the said James G. Smith and Jane B. his wife for themselves and their heirs, Executors and Administrators do covenant with the said John Sayers his heirs and assigns that the said premises are free from all encumbrances made or suffered by us, and that we have full right and power to sell convey and quit claim the same, and that we warrant & defend the same unto the said John Sayers his heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons
