Wait and Mary T. his wife of the City of Lawrence Territory of Kansas, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred Dollars to us in hand paid by George W. Hunt of the City of Lawrence of said Territory whose receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained sold and quit claimed and by these presents do bargain sell and quit claim unto the said George W. Hunt and to his heirs and assigns forever, all my right title, Estate interest, claim and demand in possession or expectancy of, in and to the following described land, situated in the City of Lawrence, aforesaid to wit: Lot Number six (6) in the Block. We have and to hold the above described premises with the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, unto the said Hunt his heirs and assigns forever, and we the said Richard G. Wait and Mary T. his wife for ourselves and our heirs, Executors and administrators do covenant with the said George W. Hunt his heirs and assigns that the said premises are free from all Encumbrances made or suffered by us; that we have full right and power to sell convey and quit claim the same and that we shall and will warrant and defend the same unto the said Hunt, his heirs and assigns
