receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold and quit claimed  
and by these presents do bargain sell and quit claim unto the said James O.  
Watson and to his heirs and assigns forever, all our right, title Estate, interest  
lawn and lawn and in possession or in expectancy of, in and to the following  
described lands, situated in the City of Lawrence aforesaid to wit: Lot Number  
six (6) on the corner, with the dwelling house thereon. To Have and to Hold  
the above described premises with the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging  
unto the said Watson and to his heirs and assigns forever. And we the said  
George and Nancy for ourselves and our heirs, Executors and Administrators  
do covenant with the said James O Watson his heirs and assigns, that the said  
premises are free from all encumbrances made or suffered by us; that we  
have full right and power to sell, convey and quit claim the same and that we  
shall and will warrant and defend the same unto the said Watson and to his  
heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all  
persons, claiming by, through or under us but against none other, and we  
the said George and Nancy our heirs, Executors, and Administrators  
are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of Three thousand  
Dollars, to the said James O Watson his heirs and assigns, to make  
and convey unto him or them all further right or title which shall or may  
be awarded or conveyed to us by any authority or by any person or persons
