

Smith to the said Wilder for the sum of lots Number Seventy Nine (79)
and Eighty One (81) in New York Street in said town of Lawrence according
to the survey of A D Seal made A.D. 1834. To my best knowledge and belief
said deed was lost about one year since, said deed does not appear
upon the records of the said town of Lawrence, said Wilder is now
absent from the County and his residence and whereabouts unknown to me
and so far as I have been able to ascertain, to any person in this community,
