 Witnesseth, that the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration
 of the sum of One Hundred and Fifty Dollars to them whereof paid
 by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknow-
 ledged have granted, bargained and sold and by these presents do grant,
 bargain and sell unto the said parties of the second part, their heirs and assigns
 all that certain piece of land situated in the corporate limits of the
 City of Lawrence in the County of and Territory aforesaid and described in
 a map or plot thereof as being Lots No One Hundred and sixteen
 (116) in Block No on New Hampshire street being on the corner
 said New Hampshire and Quincy Streets. To have and to hold
 the said premises with the appurtenances, unto the said party of the second
 part, their heirs and assigns forever. And the said parties of the first part,
 do hereby covenant with the said parties of the second part, their heirs and
 assigns, that they are lawfully seized of the premises aforesaid; that said
 premises are free and clear from all encumbrances whatsoever, and that
 they will forever warrant and defend the same, with the appurtenances
 unto the said parties of the second part, their heirs and assigns, against
 the lawful claim of all persons whomsoever. In witness whereof the said
