Know all men by these Presents, That we William T Taylor and Harriet his wife of the City of Lawrence Territory of Ottawa for and in consideration of the sum of Fifty Dollars to us in hand paid by George Ford of the same place the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained sold and quit claimed and by these presents do bargain sell and quit claim unto George Ford and his heirs and assigns forever all my right, title, Estate, interest, claim and demands, in possession or in expectancy of mine to the following described land, situated in the City of Lawrence aforesaid to wit: Lot Number One hundred nine (109) on Delaware street. To Have and to Hold the above described premises with the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said George Ford, his heirs and assigns forever, and we the said William T & Harriet Taylor for ourselves and no heads Executors and administrators, do covenant with the said George Ford his heirs and assigns that the said premises are free from all encumbrances made or suffered by us; that we have full right and power to sell convey and quit claim the same, and that we shall and will warrant and defend the same unto the said George Ford his heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons, claiming by, through or under us but against none other. And we the said William T Taylor & Harriet Taylor our heirs, Executors, and administrators, are held and firmly bound by these presents with the sum of One hundred Dollars to the said George Ford his heirs and assigns, to make and convey unto him to them all further right or title which shall or may be awarded or conveyed to us by any authority or by any person or persons by virtue of a title to the town site of Lawrence aforesaid issuing from the General Land office.
