To Have and to Hold the above described premises with the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said Charles W Hunt his heirs and assigns forever And we the said George W Hunt and Nancy Hunt for ourselves and our heirs Executors and Administrators, do covenant with the said Charles W Hunt his heirs and assigns, that the said premises are free from all Encumbrances made or suffered by us, that we have full right and property in all convey and quit claim the same and that we shall and will warrant and defend the same unto the said Charles W Hunt, his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons claiming by through or under us but against none other. And we the said George W. and Nancy A Hunt for us, Executors, and Administrators, are fully and fairly bound by these presents in the sum of Three thousand dollars to the said Charles W Hunt his heirs and assigns to make and convey unto him or them all further right in title which shall by may be awarded or conveyed to us by any authority or by any person or persons by virtue of a title to the premises of Lawrence aforesaid issuing from the several Land offices.
