Horry and to his heirs and assigns forever all my right title, estate, interest, claim and demand in possession or expectation of, in and to the following described land, situated in the City of Lawrence aforesaid, to wit: Lots forty three (43) and Forty five (45) Pennsylvania Street in the City of Lawrence Douglas County Kansas Territory to Have and to Hold the above described premises, with the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging unto the said Sumner his heirs and assigns forever. And I the said Horry for myself and my heirs, Executors and administrators, do covenant with the said Thaddeus Sumner, his heirs and assigns, that the said premises are free from all encumbrances made or suffered by me; that I have full right and power to sell, convey and quit claim the same, and that I shall and will warrant and defend the same unto the said Sumner his heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons, claiming by, through or under me but against none other. And I the said Wm H. Horry, my heirs Executors and administrators are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of One Hundred Dollars, to the said Sumner his heirs and assigns, to make and convey unto him or them all further right or title which or may be awarded or conveyed to me by any
