assigns forever all our right, title estate, interest, claim and demands, in possession
or in expectancy of us and to the following described lands, situated in the City of
Lawrence, aforesaid to wit: Lots Number Forty three (43) and Lot Number Forty
five (45) on Pennsylvania Street in said City of Lawrence as known and
designated on the Plat of said City drawn and surveyed by A D Stark. To have and
to hold the above described premises with the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging
unto the said James Leiby and his heirs and assigns forever. And we the said Eduni
Arms and Susan A Arms for ourselves and our heirs, Executors, and Administrators, do covenant
with the said James Leiby and his heirs and assigns that the said premises are free from all
encumbrances made or suffered by us, that we have full right and power to sell
carry and quit claim the same, and that we shall and will warrant and defend the
same unto the said James Leiby and his heirs and assigns forever against all lawful claims
and demands of all persons, claiming by through or under us but against none other. And
we the said Eduni Arms and Susan A Arms our heirs, Executors, and Administrators do
hereby further bind ourselves in the sum of Two Hundred Dollars to the said
James Leiby and his heirs and assigns, to make and convey unto him or them all further
right or title which shall or may be awarded or annexed to us by any authority or
