 of the City of Lawrence, Territory of Kansas, for and in consideration of the sum
 of Four hundred fifty Dollars, to me in hand paid by Henry H Flagg of sd.
 City of Lawrence the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have retained
 sold and quit claimed, and by these presents do retain and quit claim unto the said
 Henry H Flagg and to his heirs and assigns forever all my right title, Estate, interest claim
 and demands in possession and expectancy of me and to the following described lands, situated in
 the City of Lawrence aforesaid, to wit: Lot No Two Hundred and forty three (243) Louisiana
 Street and Lot No One Hundred & Eighty two (182) New Hampshire Street. To have
 and to Hold the above described premises, with the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging
 unto the said Flagg his heirs and assigns forever. And I the said Alonzo Fuller
 for myself and my heirs, Executors and administrators, do covenant with the said
 Henry H Flagg his heirs and assigns, that the said premises are free from all
 encumbrances made or suffered by me; that I have full right and power to sell away
 and quit claim the same, and that I shall and will warrant and defend the same unto
 the said Flagg his heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of
 all persons, claiming by virtue of any title or interest in me but against no other, And I the said
 Fuller my heirs, Executors, and administrators, my husband firmly bind by these
 presents in the sum of Five Thousand Dollars, to the said Flagg his heirs and
 assigns, to make and convey unto him or them all further right or title which shall
 or may be awarded or conveyed to me by any authority or by any person or persons by
 virtue of a title to the town site of Lawrence aforesaid issuing from the General Land
 Office. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty

 inted with the contents of said instrument & acknowledged that she executed the same freely and
 relinquished her right of dower to the lands and tenements therein mentioned without compulsion on the
 part of her said husband
