



Know all Men by these Presents, That I Francis Simmons of the
 City of Lawrence, Territory of Kansas, for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred
 and Twenty Dollars, to me in hand paid by Abijah W. Peck of Lyon County K.S.
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained sold and quit claimed and by these
 presents do bargain sell and quit claim unto the said Abijah W. Peck and to his heirs
 and assigns forever, all my, right title, Estate, interest, claim and demands, in possession
 or expectancy of me and to the following described lands, situated in the City of Lawrence
 aforesaid, to wit: Lot One Hundred and Thirty one (191) on Ohio Street in said
 of Lawrence according to survey made by A. D. Seal A.D. 1854. To have and
 to Hold the above described premises, with the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging
 unto the said Abijah W. Peck and his heirs and assigns forever, And I the said Francis
 Simmons for myself and my heirs, Executors, and Administrators, do covenant
 with the said Abijah W. Peck, his heirs and assigns, that the said premises are
 free from all Encumbrances made or suffered by me; that I have full right
 and power to all convey and quit claim the same, and that I shall and will warrant
 and defend the same unto the said Abijah W. Peck and to his heirs and assigns
 forever against the lawful claims, and demands of all persons, claiming by virtue of
 under me but against none other, And I the said Francis Simmons my heirs
 Executors, and Administrators are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum
 of Two hundred and fifty Dollars, to the said Abijah W. Peck and to his heirs
 and assigns, to make and convey unto him or them all further right or title which shall
 or may be awarded or conveyed to me by any authority or by any person or persons by
 virtue of title to the premises aforesaid issuing from the General Land Office
 In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty seventh
 day of January A.D. 1859.
