 of Suffolk and Commonwealth of Massachusetts Merchant, do hereby constitute  
 and appoint Edmund D. Whitman of the Territory of Kansas to be my true  
 and lawful attorney for me and in my name to manage and direct and to sell  
 and convey any and all Real Estate, and any and all rights to the same, and  
 in any and all agreements for the conveyance of the same which I now hold or may  
 hereafter acquire by purchase under a certain agreement with said Whitman of an  
 even date with this, in such lots and parcels, for such prices and on such terms  
 of payment as he shall judge best and to make, execute acknowledge and deliver any  
 and all instruments necessary to make such conveyance effectual in law but  
 without covenants of Warranty of such real estate or rights therein and without  
 any covenants except that such estates and interests therein are clear of incumbrances  
 made by me, and generally to do all things necessary to carry this power into full  
 effect, hereby ratifying and confirming all and whatsoever my said Attorney  
 may do in the premises, and we the said Isaac Parker and Sarah A. Parker  
 wife of said Isaac Parker hereby also constitute and appoint said Whitman the  
 attorney for said Sarah A. Parker, for her and in her name to write in any conveyance  
 aforesaid, and convey and release all right of dower or other right which said Sarah  
 A. Parker may by law have in any and all real estate above mentioned and to do  
 all things necessary to carry this power into full effect. In Witness whereof  
 we the said Isaac Parker and Sarah A. Parker wife of the said Isaac have  
 hereunto set our hands and seals this seventeenth day of February AD  
 Eighteen hundred and fifty seven.
