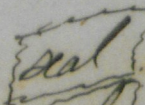


Survey of said City made by A. D. Searl, A. D.

 ises, with the privileges and appurtenances there-
 to belonging, unto the said John B. Mieg, Bish-
 op, as aforesaid. And we the said William H. R.
 and Cornelia Lykins for ourselves and ourselves
 and our heirs, executors and administrators, do Cov-
 enant with the said John B. Mieg Bishop
 as aforesaid, his heirs and assigns, that the said prem-
 ises are free from all encumbrances made or suffer-
 ed by us; that we have full right, and power
 to sell, convey and quit claim the same, and
 that we shall and will warrant and defend
 the same unto the said John B. Mieg Bishop
 as aforesaid his heirs and assigns forever, against
 the lawful claims and demands of all persons
 claiming by, through or under us but against
 none other. And we the said William H. R. Ly-
 kins and Cornelia Lykins our heirs, executors
 and administrators, are held and firmly bound
 by the presents in the sum of one thousand dol-
 lars, to the said John B. Mieg, Bishop as
 aforesaid his heirs and assigns, to make and
 convey unto him or them all further right or
 title which shall or may be awarded or convey-
 to us by any authority, or by any person or persons
 by virtue of a title to the Town Site of Lawrence,
 aforesaid, issuing from the general land office,
 this deed being made in place of one conveying
 same property of date 18 January 1859 which was
 incorrectly made out. In witness whereof

 first day of March A D 1859.
