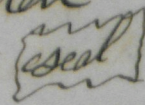


and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining, both in law and equity.

This grant is intended as a mortgage, to secure the payment of the sum of three hundred and fifty dollars with interest at four percent per month from date until paid, according to the conditions of 3 certain promissory notes this day executed and delivered by the said George S. Thompson party of first part to the said party of the second part and this conveyance shall be void if such payment be made as herein specified. But if default be made in the payment, or any part thereof as above provided then it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part his heirs executors administrators or assigns, at any time thereafter, to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof in the manner prescribed by law and out of all the moneys arising from such sale to retain the amount then due for principal and interest together with the costs and charges of making such sale and the attorneys fees for foreclosure, and the overplus if any there be, shall be paid by the party making such sale, on demand to the said George S.
