through or under me but against none
other. And the said Hiram Hill for
myself my heirs executors administrators
are held and firmly bound by these pres-
ents in the sum of two hundred and fifty
dollars to the said Nathan Stark his
heirs and assigns to make and convey
unto him or them all further right
or title which shall or may be awarded
or conveyed to me by any authority, or
by any person or persons by virtue of a
title to the town site of Lawrence
aforesaid issuing from the general
