This Indenture Made this Sixth day of April. A.D. 1859, between John Gilmore, of Douglas County, Kansas Territory party of the first part, and Nathan Stark of Williamsburgh Mass party of the Second part. Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, doth give grant, bargain sell and release, convey and confirm unto the said party of the Second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever all the following, described land, situated in the City of Lawrence Kansas Territory, to wit, Lot Seventy three (73), Seventy five (75), Seventy seven (77) & Seventy nine (79) on Indiana Street in West Lawrence, together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in anywise appertaining, both in law and equity.

This Grant is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of one hundred dollars with interest at the rate of ten per cent per annum six months from the date of this instrument, one hundred and fifty dollars one year from this date with interest as aforesaid & one hundred and fifty dollars two years from this date with interest as aforesaid. This conveyance shall be void if payment be made as herein as specified, but if default be made in the payments or any part thereof, as provided, then it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part
