This Indenture made this Eleventh day of April in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty nine, between Brinton W. Woodward of the City of Lawrence Kansas Territory of the first part, and Caleb Woodward of the Township of Marlborough, Chester Co, Pennsylvania of the second part. Witnesseth, that the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Fifteen Hundred Dollars, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, doth give, grant bargain, sell, release convey and confirm unto the party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever, all the following described land situated in the City of Lawrence Kansas Territory, to wit Twenty feet front of Lot number fourteen (14) on Massachusetts Street, situate, twenty feet South of the North boundary of said lot - and extending the full length of said lot, together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining both in law and equity. This grant is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Fifteen Hundred Dollars with interest at the rate of ten per cent per annum according to the conditions of a certain promissory note executed and delivered by the said B. W. Woodward on the 30th day of March A.D. 1859, to the said party of the second part, and this conveyance shall be void if such payment be made as herein specified, but if default be made in payment or any part thereof as above provided, then it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part his executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law, and out of all the moneys -
