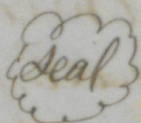

heirs and assigns, forever that neither they the
said Company nor any ~~his~~ person or persons
claiming from or under them, in the name,
right, or stead of them shall or will, by any
way or means, have claim or demand any
right or title to the afore said premises, or their
appurtenances, or to any part or parcel thereof for
ever, that they will warrant and defend the
same from all encumbrances, so far as ~~by~~ made
by through or under them but not other
