assigns from all my right title Estate, interest, claim and demand  
in possession or in expectancy of me and to the following described  
land, situated in Lawrence Douglas County tract: Lot Number  
Seventy two (72) Delaware St. To Have and to Hold the above  
described premises, with the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging  
unto the said John L. Bronson his heirs and assigns forever. And  
I the said John L. Bronson for myself and my heirs, Executors and  
Administrators do covenant with the said O' Hilmorth his heirs  
and assigns that the said premises are free from all encum-  
brances made or suffered by me; that I have full right and
