of City of Lawrence Territory of Kansas, of the second part. Witnesseth that the said
party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of Fifty Dollars to
him in hand paid by the said party of the second part the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained and sold, and by these
presents does grant bargain and sell unto the said party of the second part his
hus and assigns, all that certain piece or parcel of land situated in City of
Lawrence Territory of Kansas, known as Lot No fifty one (51) on Maryland
Street in the aforesaid City of Lawrence and bounded as follows commencing at
a point fifty (50) feet south of the south West corner of Berkley and Maryland
Streets three West One hundred and seventeen feet, then south fifty feet three
East one hundred and seventeen feet - thence North to place of beginning fifty feet.
To Have and to Hold the said premises with the appurtenances, unto the said party
of the second part his heirs and assigns forever. And the said party of the first
part does hereby covenant with the said party of the second part his heirs
and assigns, that he is lawfully seized of the premises aforesaid; that said
premises are free and clear from all encumbrances whatsoever, and that he will
from thenceforth and defend the same, with the appurtenances, unto the said
party of the second part his heirs and assigns against the lawful claims of
all persons claiming or to claim from, under or by virtue of any title granted
