 of the same place the receipt whereof being acknowledged have bargained sold
 and quit claimed and by these presents do bargain sell and quit claim unto
 the said Rufus S Bassett and to his heirs and assigns forever, all our right title
 Estate interest claim and demand we make to the following described land
 situated in the City of Lawrence aforesaid town: The North half of lot
 Number Seventeen (17) in Massachusetts Street. To Have and to Hold the
 above described premises with the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging unto
 the said Rufus S Bassett his heirs and assigns forever. And we the said
 Richard G Wait and Mary his wife for ourselves and our heirs, Executors
 and Administrators, do warrant with the said Rufus S Bassett his heirs and
 assigns, that the said premises are free from all Encumbrance made or suffered
 by us; that we have full right and power to sell away and quit claim the same
 and that we shall and will warrant and defend the same unto the said Rufus
 S Bassett his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands
 of all persons claiming by through or under us but against none other. And
 we the said Richard G Wait and Mary our heirs, Executors and Administrators are
 held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of One thousand Dollars
 to the said Rufus S Bassett his heirs and assigns to make and convey unto him
 or them all further right or title which shall or may be awarded or conveyed to us
 by any authority or by any person or persons by virtue of a bill to the town of
 Lawrence aforesaid issuing from the General Land office whom soever
 In Witness Whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals this fourt
