

Know all men by these presents. That we, the said Thomas and Hannah Thomas, wife of said Joel of Lawrence in the County of Douglas and Territory of Kansas, for divers good causes and considerations thereunto moving and especially in consideration of three hundred dollars paid by Charles H. Branscomb, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged of said Lawrence, do grant, bargain and sell to the said Branscomb his heirs and assigns a certain lot of land situated in said Lawrence and known as lot Number eighteen on Rhode Island Street according to the Survey made of said Lawrence by A. D. Seal, to which reference is had for a particular description, together with all the appurtenances thereto belonging. And for ourselves and our heirs do covenant with the said Branscomb his heirs and assigns, that we will warrant and defend the premises hereby conveyed against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever — In testimony whereof the said Joel Thomas and the said Hannah Thomas, wife of said Joel in token of my release of all right of dower in the premises, have hereunto set our hands and seals this thirtieth day of April A. D. 1859.
