And I the said D. W. Holbrook and my heirs and executors, and administrators are held and firmly bound by these presents, in the sum of two hundred dollars, to the said R. W. Ludington his heirs and assigns to make and convey unto him or them all further right or title which shall or may be awarded or conveyed to me by any authority, or by any person or persons by virtue of a title to the town site of Lawrence aforesaid issuing from the general land office.
