Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, doth give, grant bargain, sell, release, convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part and to his husband assigns forever, all the following described land, situated in Lawrence Douglas County Kansas Territory, to wit, Lot number one hundred and forty two (142) New York Street, together with all and singular the heredaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining both in law and equity.
