

This Indenture made this Thirtieth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty nine between Charles A. Pease of Douglas County, Kansas Territory, of the first part, and George C. Chandler of Lawrence, County and Territory aforesaid of the second part, Witnesseth. That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred Dollars the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, doth give grant, bargain, sell, release, convey, and confirm unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever, all the following described land situated in Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas Territory, to wit,

Being Lot number fifty four on Massachusetts Street. (No 54 Mass) and premises thereon standing together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining, both in law and equity. This Grant is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Two hundred Dollars & interest according to the conditions of certain promissory note this day executed and delivered by the said Charles A. Pease to the said party of the second part, and this conveyance shall be void if such payment be made as herein specified. But if default be made in payment or any part thereof, as above provided then it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part, his executors, administrators and assigns at any time thereafter, to sell the premises hereby granted, any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law, and out of all the money arising from such sale, to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the costs and charges of making such sale and the attorney fees for foreclosure, and the overplus if any there be shall be paid by the party making such sale on demand to the said Charles A. Pease his heirs or assigns.
