

Know all men by these presents; That I James Garvin of the City of Lawrence, Territory of Kansas, for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred dollars to him in hand paid by C. A. Reynolds of Lawrence Kansas the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained and sold and quit claimed, and by these presents do bargain sell and quit claim unto the said C. A. Reynolds and to his heirs and assigns forever, all the right, title & estate in land situated in the city of Lawrence Kansas, to wit, Lot No. Sixty three (63) Rhode Island Street as surveyed by A. T. Stark. To have and to hold the above described premises, with the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, unto the said C. A. Reynolds and to his heirs and assigns forever. And I the said James Garvin for myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, do covenant with the said C. A. Reynolds his heirs and assigns, that the said premises are free from all encumbrances made or suffered by me; that I have full right and power to sell, convey and quit claim the same, and that I shall and will warrant and defend the same unto the said C. A. Reynolds his heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons claiming through or under me but against none other.

And I the said James Garvin, his executors and administrators, are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of Five hundred dollars, to the said C. A. Reynolds his heirs and assigns, to make and pay unto him or them all further right or title which shall or may be required or conveyed to me by any authority, or by any person or persons who ever.
