I know all men by these presents. That I, S. L. Sads  
of the Town of Lawrence Territory of Mansa, for and in  
consideration of the sum of Two Hundred Dollars to me  
in hand paid by Wm. H. Sykins of the Town aforesaid  
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained  
sold and quit claimed. And by these presents do bargain,  
sell and quit claim unto the said Wm. H. Sykins and  
to his heirs and assigns forever all my right little estate,  
interest claim and demand in propriety or in expectancy  
of, in and to the following described land, situated in the  
Town of Lawrence aforesaid. To wit Lot number Twenty  
Five 25 in Rhode Island Street - I have and to hold  
the above described premises with the privileges and appur-  
tenances therunto belonging, unto the said Sykins and to  
his heirs and assigns forever. And I the said Sads for  
myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, do  
everlastingly will the said Sykins his heirs and assigns,  
that the said premises are free from all encumbrances  
made or suffered by me. That I have full right and  
power to sell, convey and quit claim the same and that  
I shall and will warrant and defend the same unto the  
said Sykins his heirs and assigns forever, against the  
claims of all persons whomsoever, claiming to have or to lay  
any claim to the same. The said Sads by him and assigns, are fully  
and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of Four Hundred  
Dollars, to the said Sykins his heirs, executors and adminis-  
trators to make and convey unto him or them all further right  
or title to which shall or may be awarded or conveyed to me
