 sell and quit claim unto the said E. Murdock his heirs
 executors, Administrators, and assigns, forever all my
 right, title, interest, claim, and demand in and to the
 following described land, situate and lying in the City
 of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas, according to the
 survey made by A. S. Seal A.D. 1854 - To wit - Lot
 No. Twenty Seven (27) Part - And I John S. Crane
 aforesaid my heirs, executors, Administrators and assigns
 are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum
 of One Hundred Dollars, to said E. Murdock aforesaid his
 heirs, executors, Administrators, and assigns to well and
 truly execute over and convey unto him or them all the title
 which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said City of
 Lawrence or from any person or persons whomsoever, to any
 part of the above described property, to have and to hold the
 same, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto
 belonging, forever -
