J. Yunker aforesaid his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of Thirty Five Dollars to said John Mack aforesaid his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which J the said J. J. Yunker shall receive from the Trust or any other source to any and all of the above described property to have and to hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances therunto belonging forever -
