Lof for myself and my heirs executors and administrators do covenant with the said Hutchinson and his heirs and assigns, that the said premises are free from all encumbrances made or suffered by me that ~~me~~ that I have full right and power to sell convey and quit claim the same and that I shall and will warrant and defend the same unto the said Hutchinson and his heirs and assigns forever, against the claims and demands of all persons claiming by, through or under but against none other. And I the George W. Lof my heirs and assigns, are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of Two Hundred Dollars, to the said Hutchinson his heirs executors and administrators to make and convey unto him or them all further right or title which shall or may be asserted or conveyed to me by any authority, or by any person or persons, by virtue of a title to the Town Site of Lawrence aforesaid issuing from the general Land Office.
