paid by Henry Campbell of aforesaid place the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained sold and
quit claimed and by these presents do bargain sell and
quit claim unto the said Henry Campbell his heirs executors
administrators, and assigns forever all my right title interest
claim and demand in and to the following described
land, situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the
State of Kansas according to the Survey made by A.S.
Pearl A.D. 1854 to wit: Lot no. Fourteen (14) Corner of
Street And I George Carey aforesaid my heirs executors
administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by
these presents in the sum of One Hundred Dollars to said
Henry Campbell aforesaid his heirs executors administrators
and assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto
him or them all the title which I shall receive from
the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any
power or person or persons whomsoever, to any and all
of the above described property, to have and to hold the same
with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto
belonging forever -
