

Know all Men by these presents: That I William H R Sykins of the Town of Lawrence in the Territory of Kansas for and in consideration of the sum of Thirty Dollars to me in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by Richard E. Whiteside of the Town and Territory aforesaid have bargained sold, and quit claim and by these presents do bargain sell and quit claim unto the said Richard E. Whiteside his heirs executors, administrators and assigns forever all my right title and interest claim and demand in and to the following described land situated and lying in the Town of Lawrence, Territory of Kansas according to the survey made by A.D. Lewis A.D. 1854 to wit: Lot number Twenty Five (25) on Lafayette Place - And I William H R Sykins my heirs executors administrators and assigns am held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of One Hundred Dollars to the Richard E. Whiteside aforesaid, his heirs executors, administrators and assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the Town of Lawrence or from any power or persons whomsoever, to any and all of the above described property to have and to hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging forever -
