Farraba of Lawrence County of Kansas the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold and quit claimed, and by these presents do bargain, sell, and quit claim unto the said Judson A. Farraba his heirs, executors, Administrators, and assigns forever, all my right, title, interest, claim, and demand in and to the following described land, situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the County of Kansas, according to the survey made by A.D. Scott, A.D. 1854 - To wit - Lot One Hundred and twenty five (125) Maryland Street - And Matthew H. Spittle agrees his heirs, executors, Administrators and assigns, are held, and firmly bound by these presents, in the sum of One Hundred Dollars, to said Judson A. Farraba aforesaid, his heirs, executors, Administrators and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which they shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence or from any power, person or persons whatsoever, to any and all of the above described
