 sum of Three Hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by Henry
 Campbell of aforesaid place the receipt whereof is hereby ack-
 -nowledged, have bargained, sold, and quit claimed, and by these
 presents do bargain, sell, and quit claim unto the said Henry
 Campbell his heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns
 forever all my right, title, interest, claim, and demand in and
 to the following described lands situate and lying in the
 Town of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas, according to the
 Survey made by A. D. Hunt A. D. 1854 - to wit: Lot no
 Sixty Two (62) Entirely Situated with the house and barn
 and appurtenances therunto belonging And I Egn O'Hush
 aforesaid my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns
 do hereby and firmly bound by these presents, in the sum of
 Six Hundred Dollars to said Henry Campbell aforesaid his
 heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, to well and lawfully
 make over and convey unto him or them all the title which
 I shall receive from the District of the said Town of Lawrence
 or from any person or persons whatsoever, to any and
 all of the above described property - to have and to hold
 the same with all the privileges and appurtenances therunto
 belonging forever -
