And I the said Achilles Wade hereby transfer unto the said Albert D. Sears and his heirs and assigns the aforesaid lots they having been allotted to me the said Wade as part payment in consideration of my abandoning my claim to a quarter section of land included with the said tract, the above described lots being one half of my present right and property situate within said claim, And I further covenant and agree to convey and quit claim unto the said Sears and his heirs and assigns one half of any and all lots hereafter made out of any lands included within said tract which has not <sup>yet</sup> been divided into lots which shall belong to and be allotted to the said Wade -

To have and to hold the aforesaid lots together with one half of my interest and right to all lands not yet divided into lots unto the said Albert D. Sears his heirs and assigns forever - And I hereby agree to warrant and defend the aforesaid property unto the said (Albert D. Sears), his heirs and assigns against any and all person claiming through or under me - In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this nineteenth day of March in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty seven signed sealed and delivered
